- Veterinarian (Vet) – a doctor for animals
- Animal shelter – a place where stray, lost, or abandoned animals are looked after

- To adopt – to permanently care for an animal
- To foster – to care for animals until they find a permanent home
- To pet – to stroke or pat an animal affectionately

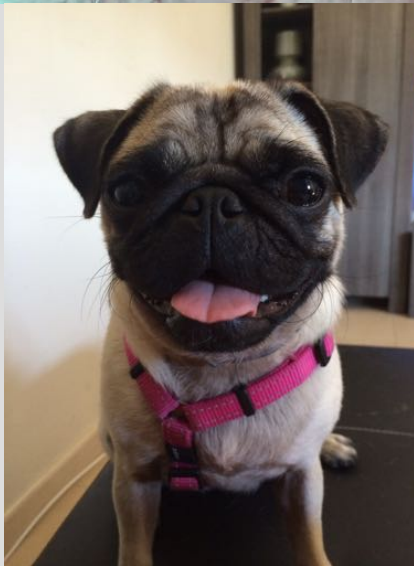

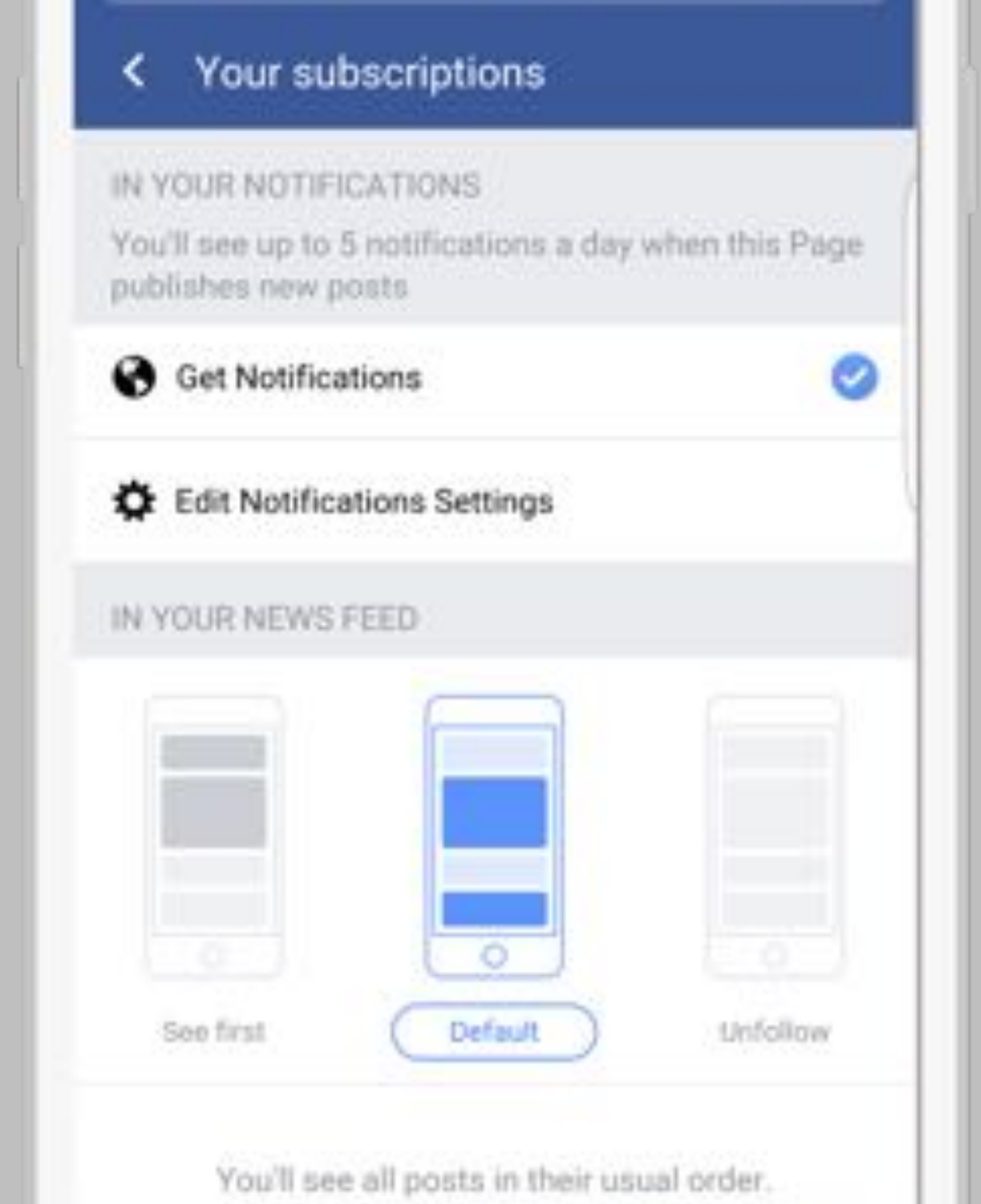
