GIVING DIRECTIONS

Knowing how to ask/give directions is very useful:

- So you don't get lost!
- You help others
- You interact with local people

HOW TO ASK FOR DIRECTIONS

- I'm lost. Can you help me?
- Where can I find main street please?
- Which is the best way to the post office?
- How do I get to the beach from here?

ASK FOR DIRECTIONS

What you should say first:

- Excuse me
- Excuse me Madam or Excuse me Sir
- Hello! I'm lost, can you help me please?

FINDING YOUR WAY WITH PUBLIC TRANSPORT

- In London, you should say:
 - Where's the nearest tube station?
- In the States, you should say:
 - Where's the nearest subway station?

FINDING YOUR WAY WITH PUBLIC TRANSPORT

- Does the number 33 bus stop outside the train station?
- How often does the airport bus run?
- At what stop do I need to get off at to reach the Science museum?

HOW TO GIVE DIRECTIONS

- Turn left/right
- Make a left/right
- Take a left/right
- Go straight
- Carry straight on
- Continue straight ahead

HOW TO GIVE DIRECTIONS

- Go north/south/east/west
- Head north/south/east/west
- Walk down this avenue
- Walk up to the next junction

HOW TO GIVE DIRECTIONS

- It's around the corner
- It's across the street
- It's two blocks away
- It's on the other side of the street

HOW TO GIVE DIRECTIONS

- It's too far to walk
- You need to take a taxi or catch the bus
- You should go by metro

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

- Follow the signs to the airport
- It's well signposted
- Take exit 55
- It's a 5-minute drive
- It's about a mile away
- It's about a kilometre away

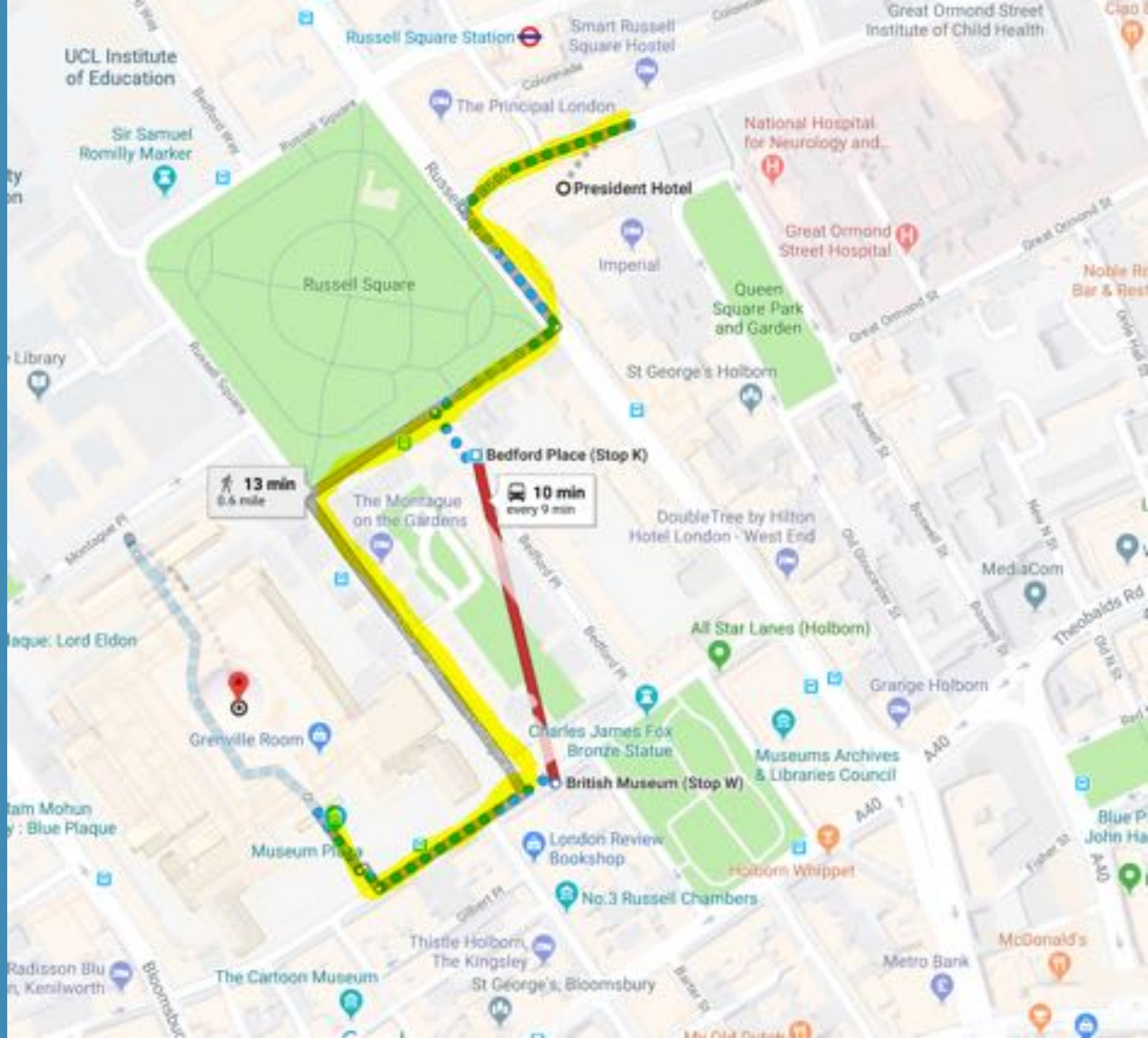
DRIVING DIRECTIONS

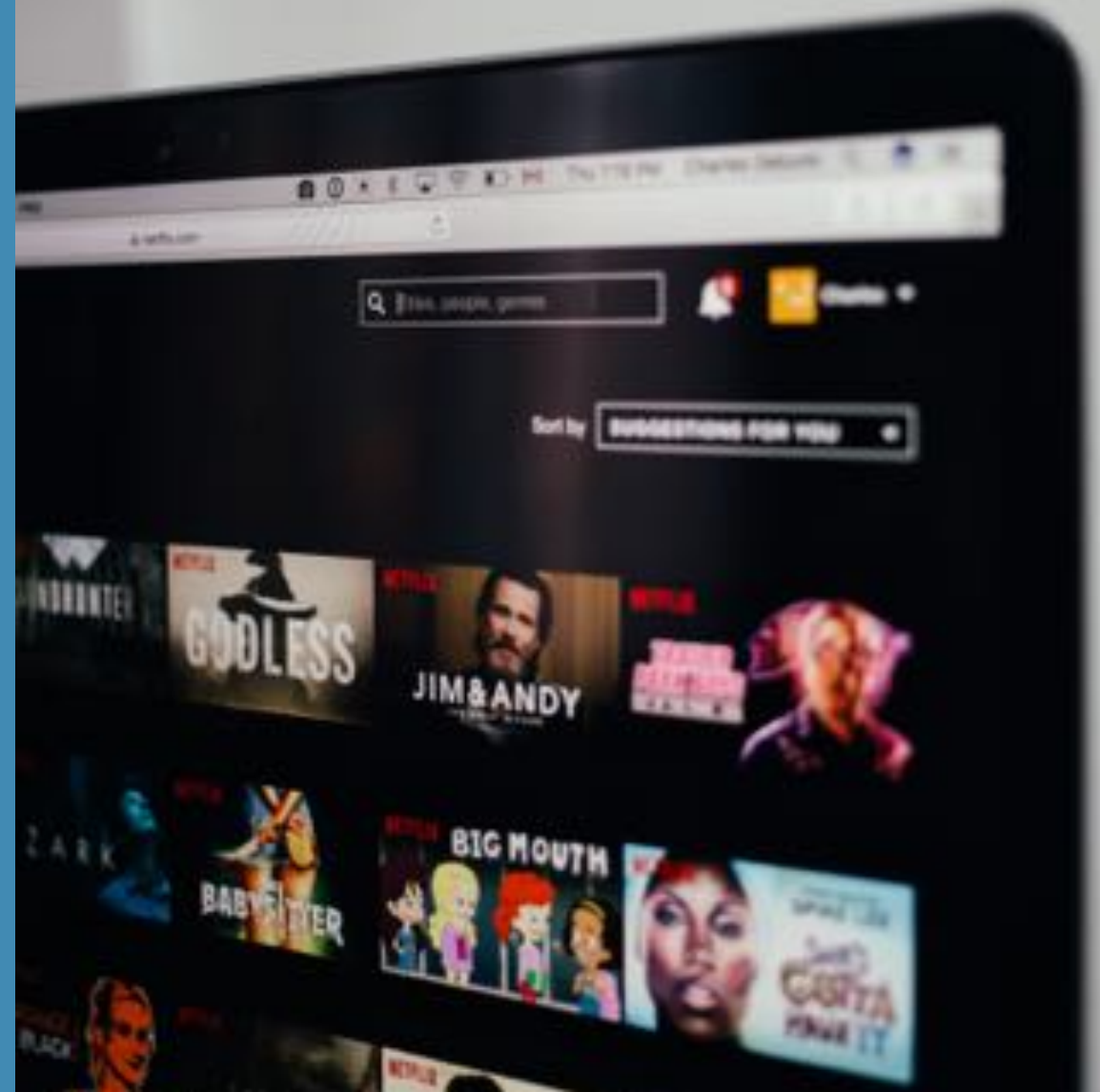

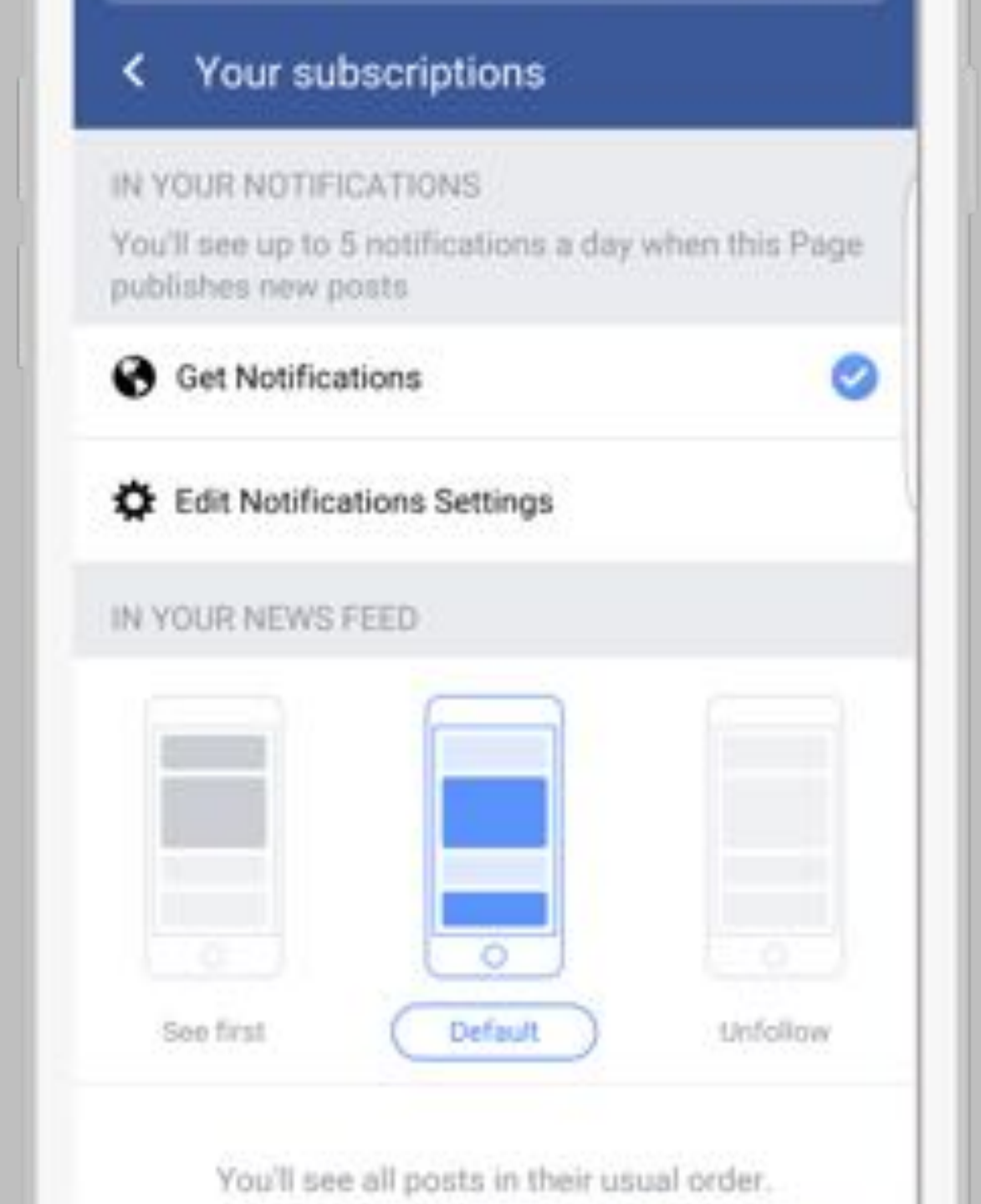
