- Phrasals tend to have multiple meanings

In the kitchen:

- I'll **put** the kettle **on**...
- Can you please take out the trash...
- I've dropped milk on the floor, I need to **mop** it **up**...

In the living room:

- Can you please switch the TV off when you're not watching it...
- Turn on the lights, please!
- We are decorating and we need to take all of our pictures down.

In the bedrooms:

- Can you pick up your clothes and hang them up in your wardrobe...
- Tidy your room up! It's a mess!
- Turn your music down! It's too loud.

In the bathroom:

- Can you clean up after having your shower!
- Put your make-up on in the bathroom, please!
- Can you put your shaving cream away once you've finished with it?

In the garden:

- We'll need to pick up the dead leaves soon.
- Help me sweep up the patio floor please.
- We dug up the soil in the garden last Saturday.

In the hall:

- Hang your coat up on the coat stand...
- Take off your jacket
- Put on your slippers

The weather is dry, give me a hand **hanging** the clothes **out** on the line.

It's raining, quick let's **bring** the washing **in**.


